



The CIVIC IMPACT OF OPERA

AN EVIDENCE BASE

Using the Opera Civic Impact Framework, unique to the Canadian opera sector, the AOC measures the collective civic impact of opera companies from coast to coast.

Between 2021 and 2022, seven opera companies in Canada participated in data collection efforts, deploying a total of 400 surveys that were completed by participants and audience members attending the opera performances and programs during the pandemic.

Opera Atelier (Toronto, ON): Angel - An original 70-minute opera ballet film

Manitoba Opera (Winnipeg, MB): The performances of The Telephone and La Voix Humane

Pacific Opera Victoria (Victoria, BC): Open Air: A Summer Festival of Music

reNaissance Opera (Vancouver, BC): Annual IndieFest - A series of events centered around collective healing and building a sustainable future

INDICATOR	OUTCOME
JOY	95% of survey respondents enjoyed the opera experience. The use of technology, real-time XR for livestreaming, and a blend of new and familiar elements were appreciated by the audience. Participants highlighted the opportunity to use their voices without judgment, and teachers found the interactions with participants gratifying.
RELATABLE	61% of respondents felt that opera was more relevant than they originally thought, and 64% gained a deeper appreciation of opera as an art form. The performances were found to be relatable, invigorating interest in the arts, and providing access to cultural experiences.
WELCOMING	90% of respondents felt that the atmosphere at opera performances was warm, open, and inviting. Participants praised the welcoming environment, fostering cultural exchange and respect among attendees.
WELLBEING	73% reported that attending the opera had a positive impact on their mental health and well-being. The opera experience was described as a means to escape the daily routine, allowing attendees to dream, imagine, and be transported into another realm.
CHANGING HEARTS & MINDS	73% experienced strong emotional reactions during opera performances. 32% reported that the opera experience altered their worldview, while 41% felt motivated to engage in dialogue or action related to the covered topics.
COMMUNITY	Attending opera performances contributed to community cohesion, with 55% feeling more proud of their culture and/or community, 52% feeling more connected to their local community, and 26% feeling more connected to others who are different from themselves.
